

## PE

Year 1 will work on their ball skills in outside PE. In gymnastics, both year groups will create wide, narrow and curled shapes with their bodies and will learn how to transition between each.

## Computing

Year 1 will learn how to programme animations using ScratchJr. They will learn how to select a 'sprite' and background for their animations and how to use programming blocks to command the sprite to move in different ways.

## Music

This term, Squirrels will have weekly sessions with Katie Harris from Oxfordshire County Music Service. They will explore musical stories.

## Character

We will explore positivity through our 'Zog' Commando Joes missions. Our weekly Forest School sessions will continue to build our perseverance and problem-solving skills.

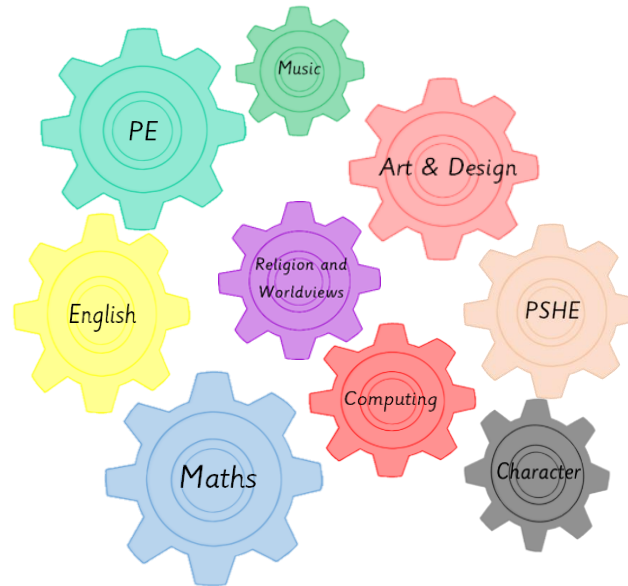
# Year Group: Reception and Year 1

## Our topic is *Tell me a story...*

### Overview

Our Summer 1 project focuses on telling and sharing stories. We will be exploring it through English, Art, PSHE, COJO'S, Music and PE based activities.

Our WOW launch will include exploring our library, storytelling and book making role-play area. At the start of the term, we will enjoy an Art Week where we will create large carnival inspired puppets. We will also be visiting the Story Museum to explore story telling and to gain inspiration for our own fantasy stories.



### PSHE

Our SCARF lessons will focus on 'Rights and Respect'. We will learn about how people behave and how we can make choices to help others; how we can look after our school environment and living things; and what money is used for and how we can look after the money we have.

### Art

We will be creating large carnival puppets during Art Week. Throughout the term we will explore drawing and illustration as part of our 'Tell me a story...' project.

### English

This term we will be using the text 'Stanley's Stick' by John Hegley. To begin with we will spend some time familiarising ourselves with the story and exploring how Stanley uses his stick in imaginative ways. We will write our own fantasy story. We will also use 'The Magic Bed' by John Burningham to help us describe settings and story events. We will continue to focus on our letter formation in handwriting.

### Maths

Both year groups will continue with Mastering Number sessions to build fluency and confidence. Year 1 will also explore multiplication and division. They will also be learning about fractions including finding half and quarter of shapes and quantities.
