Dear Families,

Easter has passed and we are into the Summer term, the final term of the year. It's always a busy one, with lots of learning, loads of events and as we prepare our Y6's for their next stage of education in Secondary school, we also welcome our new Reception children who will join us in September. We are currently working on the arrangements for teaching and learning for next year, the final plan won't be available until July, but we have some lovely news to share. Miss Elise Yearsley, currently working with Kites Class in her final teaching practice with Brookes University, will be joining the Wroxton team permanently from September. She has already become a valued member of the team and we know you will all make her feel really welcome. Mrs Julie Jennings is also confirmed to be joining the Wroxton team permanently working with our youngest children. Julie will be reaching out to families with new Reception pupils during June and we will arrange for them to come and spend some time in their new school. We only have two spare places for next year's Reception, so if you know anyone who might have a child looking to start school this year that hasn't chosen Wroxton, do let them know, we would be happy to show them around.

In other good news, it has been agreed that the Eagles outside area will get a revamp this Summer, with a new Astro surface which will enable us to smarten up this important provision for our youngest children and add some more opportunities for their outside physical play and development. The roof work is complete and Justine tells me we can already see a reduction in the volume of fuel oil being used because the insulation in the new roof is so good! We are also benefitting from the improved light and ventilation system and the CCTV is really helping us to look carefully not only at who is on site, but also events outside as they happen. This has already helped in some conversations with children when things have not gone as everyone would have wished.

Further investment from ODST has also been confirmed to refurbish the front of school and change the doors to make entering and exiting not only easier, but more welcoming for all. The Music Room project has now been ratified by the Trust and the additional funding needed to aid it coming to fruition is in the pipeline. The planning application has been made and the current, tentative expectation, is that ground could be cut on this project, assuming all is agreed with planning, in late 2025. Ahead of this the new fencing will be erected just as soon as planning is confirmed for it. The investment by ODST in our school over this year and next will amount to well over £120,000 with a further commitment for the replacement of the boiler in the pipeline, bringing it to around £225,000 by the time it is all completed.





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This is a very strong indication of the commitment from Trustees towards Wroxton and is very much welcomed.

Thank you to everyone who has donated things for our loose parts play. Playtimes are transforming and we can now confirm we are officially an 'O.P.A.L' School. This stands for 'Outdoor Play and Learning'. This is a national organisation working to transform the 20% of children's time at school which is 'playtime' but is frequently overlooked. Play is a Human Right under Article 31 of the UN Convention of the Rights of the Child, and it is our ambition at Wroxton to make sure all our children make the most of this important time each day with their friends and have a wide and varied range of play to meet all their needs.
