Mrs Jo Wootton has joined us, working largely in Kestrels as an experienced Teaching Assistant. Thank you for making her feel welcome.

After half term, Mrs Andrea Wistow will be joining us as the full time teacher in Falcons class. Y6 families have received a detailed letter regarding this. Andrea is a very experienced Y6 teacher and subject leader and joins us replacing the teaching position held by Mrs Taylor and made vacant by her retirement. Mrs Di Giorno will continue as the Assistant Headteacher working to support teaching and learning, curriculum development and leading English and play across both Wroxton and St Mary's.

#### Regarding communication with the leadership team.

If you have a question, query or issue, please always go to your class teacher first. They are the person with your child every day. Mrs Sullivan deals with lunches, money, medical and absence issues but not teaching and learning. If you need further support, then Mrs Di Giorno, as Assistant Headteacher is on site pretty much every day and leads the day to day teaching and learning organisation, lunchtime, play and events. Ms Bailey is Executive Deputy Head and is at school 2 or three days a week. She can be contacted via the office if she is not on site and will contact you by phone or email regarding anything to do with additional or special needs and family support work. I am in school one or two days a week, focusing on the strategic and business needs of school, working with our Trust officers on things like the site development and also with Mrs Di Giorno and Ms Bailey supporting the development of the curriculum and quality of education in school. This does mean that it is very likely that I will not be 'hands on' in every issue you may want support with, but please be assured that we work very closely as a senior leadership team and Ms Bailey and Mrs Di Giorno have the skill, experience and authority to take decisions and carry out their roles fully.

We are fully aware this is a new system for school; it is for us and St Mary's as well. But in order to ensure that schools remain financially viable, can offer the full range of education, experiences and services, this model is increasingly the chosen one. In ODST there are some 8 or 9 similar partnerships and more planned whilst other local Multi Academy Trusts, both small and large, all have similar models. When any of us are in school at the start or end of the day and not otherwise engaged, we try to ensure we are on the gates, please do come and talk to us, we are really happy to chat and find out more about our community.
