Staffing.

As you know, Mrs Taylor is retiring at Christmas and we will be wishing her a happy retirement on 20th December.

Additionally, I can now tell you that Mrs Ledo has, after much consideration and reflection, taken the very difficult decision to step away from teaching at this time in order to spend more time with her young family. We are all very sad to see her go, but as teachers and parents ourselves, we know just how hard it is to juggle both things at once and being a Mum has to come first for her at this time.

Mrs Jennings, who the children have got to know this term, will be stepping into the main class teacher role so there will be lots of continuity for the children in Eagles.

Finally, we have our own Christmas Baby due, Miss West is expecting her bundle of joy in early January and will be leaving us to get ready and have a well earned rest before the big event. I am pleased to say that Mrs Joanne Wootton has been appointed as a Teaching Assistant and will be joining the team at the start of term, I know you will all make her feel very welcome.

Sadly, without Mrs Ledo or Miss West in school, we will not have any qualified Forest School Leaders for a period of time. I am working on options around this and just as soon as a solution can be found, we will re-establish this important part of our curriculum.

Site Development News

We have been working hard with our Trust and Site Surveyor to manage a number of large projects to upgrade and develop our site. The first of these is happening in January when much of our flat roofing will be replaced. This project, costing well over £100k and being funded by ODST, will involve extensive scaffolding being put up around the building for a few weeks. We will let you know if it affects any of the routines for school, such as routes in and out, although this is unlikely. This will mean that the water ingress we regularly suffer during heavy rain will be solved and the building will be less damp in places than it currently is.

Additionally, planning is currently underway to replace the boundary fencing with fencing of a more up to date standard. It will be higher and more secure for everyone and meet today's expected standard for school sites. On top of this, we also want to make sure that our beautiful but very open site, can be seen by people in the building more easily. Hence there are also plans in development for CCTV to be added to the building, covering the carpark, gates and playground. You will have seen we already have a camera in the entrance, so we can see who is coming to school before they are in the building. We know these developments are a sad

indictment on modern society, but it is important that all schools meet an expected standard of site security to ensure everyone is safe inside school. This project is also being funded by our Trust.

You may also want to know where the Music Room project is up to. For those of you unaware, this is a legacy donation of a sum of money to provide a space for music education and performance as well as house a kindly donated piano. The Local Board of Governors continues to work with the Trust to establish a workable plan to make this bequest a reality and design and planning options are at an advanced stage. As soon as we can confirm the next steps, we will let you know.

Looking ahead, we have plans to redevelop and upgrade the outdoor area of Eagles which is a little tired and worn and that we want to be as exciting for our youngest children to be playing in as their classroom is. Steps after this will include decorating the areas of school looking most tired and redeveloping our library space to be a modern, vibrant and exciting place to find a book. Playtimes are just as important to us at Wroxton as classroom lessons, so Mrs Di Giorno is leading a drive to enable our breaktimes to be filled with a wider variety of play and activity and we look forward to watching this develop over the coming months.

Finally, we have completed an audit of IT equipment available to our pupils and in the coming weeks we will be bringing a significant number of Chrome Books online so that the work the children do in Computing and across the curriculum using IT, can be better supported. Some of this will be funded by the 'Blue Tokens' from Tesco's project, so thank you for all that shopping!

REMINDER!! Changes to school Day

As we said in September the school day will be changing slightly from 8th January 2024.

School registration will be at **8.45am**, **5 minutes earlier** than currently. The gates will there for open at **8.35am**. Children should not arrive before this time.

School will finish at **3.15 pm, 15 minutes** later than currently.

Breakfast Club and Night Owls – time changes

During the Autumn we have been monitoring the use of Breakfast Club and Night Owls and we are making some slight alterations to timings which will better reflect this monitoring of use and comments and observations from families.

We recognise many people want to drop their children off at school earlier than 8.00am. Meanwhile the number of children in Night Owls after 5.45 is very low. Therefore we are adjusting the times to better support this situation.

From January 8th

- Breakfast Club will Open at 7.45am
- Night Owls will Close at 5.45pm.

We know this will be helpful to a significant number of people but will cause some difficulty for a small number. We apologise for this, but ask you to understand that this wrap around care can only be maintained if it self funded by income, we can not support it from the main school budget. We know that our provision is considerable, when compared with other local schools providing shorter and fewer sessions and we trust that everyone will appreciate and support this decision.
